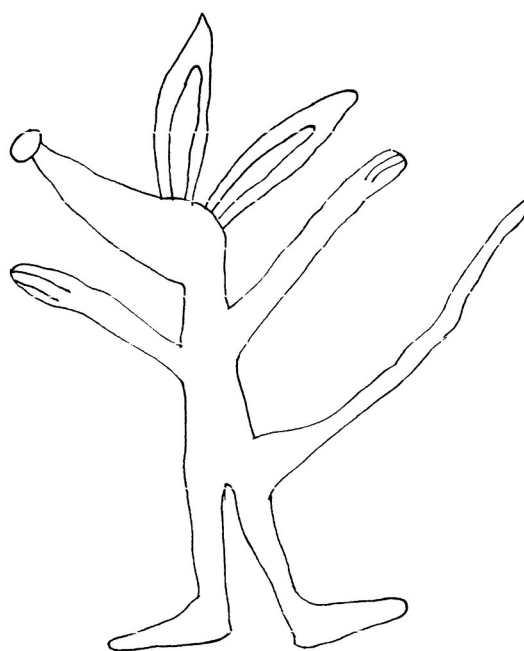
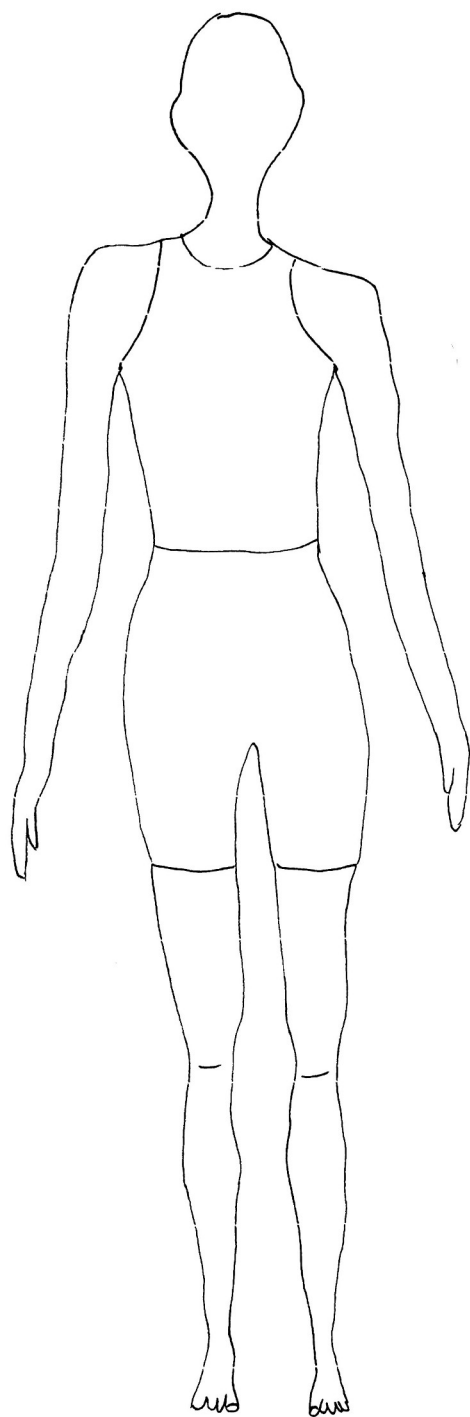
Is the person a man or a woman?
